School Superintendent

The board recognizes the importance of an effective working relationship between the board and superintendent. The board further recognizes the distinct and separate areas of responsibility of the board and superintendent to the school system. The superintendent is responsible for the administration of the system of schools consistent with the board's policies.

To maintain a cohesive relationship between the board and the school system, the superintendent shall have the following duties:

1. to serve as secretary of the board and assist all board committees;
2. to keep the board informed of the operation of the system;
3. to make recommendations to the board as required by law and board policy and as otherwise determined appropriate by the superintendent; and
4. to assist the board in making sound decisions and meeting the requirements of law by providing information and advice regarding all matters that require board action.
