The board shall elect a chairperson and a vice-chairperson to serve a term of one year or until his/her successor is elected and qualified by taking the oath of office prescribed in Article VI, Sec. 7 of the North Carolina Constitution (see board policy 2.1100, Board Member Elections). An organizational meeting for the election and qualification of officers shall be held at the regularly scheduled December meeting of the board and as often thereafter as the board shall determine appropriate. The officers shall be elected in the following order: chairperson, vice-chairperson.

If the chairperson or vice-chairperson resigns from office, the position shall be filled at the next regular meeting of the board. The individual elected must have the majority vote of all members present.

If necessary at any meeting held to elect officers, the superintendent shall serve as chairperson of the board for the purpose of conducting the election of the chairperson.
