

Board of Education Policy 3.3120

Administrative Procedure
Minimum Credit High School Diploma Program

In order for a student to receive a Minimum Credit High School Diploma, the student shall

1. complete an application process and must be accepted into the program;
2. sign an individual educational action plan contract;
3. participate in a Credit Recovery Program to recover credits for courses failed due to absenteeism and academics;
4. receive a Personal Education Plan (PEP) that shall be customized to the educational program for better instructional delivery and academic success;
5. ensure that the student's parents meet with the North Carolina Minimum Credit High School Diploma Committee and sign an agreement and be involved with the process;
6. receive services from the Student Intervention Team (Administrator, School Counselor, School Social Worker, School Nurse) that will ensure educational counseling, mentoring and social support to reduce suspensions and expulsions.
7. graduate with the minimum North Carolina Graduation Requirements.
