In support of the Board Policy 3.3000, Curriculum Development, and the board's encouragement of expanded curriculum development, the following board requirements are adopted for granting credit for alternative delivery systems:

1. The course must be approved in advance by the principal and superintendent or his/her designee.
2. A current member of the high school faculty or central office staff must supervise the student in his/her independent study work.
3. To receive credit for an independent study, the designated high school teacher must provide such essential information as is generally included in official transcripts of school records.

This information includes:

- a. identification of content of subject matter covered;
- b. a syllabus from the course instructor which includes course goals, objectives, course activities, and grade requirements;
- c. the number of clock hours of instruction in the course, if appropriate;
- d. the student's numerical/letter grade in the course.
