Driver Education will be provided as an optional extracurricular activity. The following constitutes the expectations of the board concerning the proper use of driver education cars.

1. The car is to be used only for teaching students enrolled in driver education class.
2. There will be no more than four (4) persons in the car at any one time; that is, three (3) students and the instructor.
3. The car will not be used by students to take the license examination.
4. Non-driver education class students or other personnel will not be transported in the car unless authorized by the superintendent.
5. The car will be serviced at the county school bus garage or as directed by the Director of Driver Education. The instructor will not attempt or allow any unauthorized person to make repairs to or service the vehicle.
6. The car may be used by the assigned instructor for travel to and from work and for other official school travel.
7. In case of emergency or in cases not covered by the above instructions, the instructor will use his professional judgment with the best interest of the student, and the program in mind at all times. The problem should be referred to (1) the Director of Driver Education, (2) the principal, or (3) the superintendent as the situation may warrant and time permits.
8. In case of accident, the instructor will notify the Highway Patrol or police, the Director of Driver Education, and the principal. All necessary reports will be filed by the instructor.
9. There must be at least two (2) students scheduled for instruction in the car.
