Disciplinary actions for students identified as exceptional children according to North Carolina and federal guidelines shall conform to *Policies Governing Services for Children with Disabilities* as adopted by the State Board of Education. If the *Policies* manual does not fully address a particular issue, the director of exceptional children shall develop any necessary protocols consistent with state and federal law.
