All schools should educate students about the role of humanitarian agencies in the community and the importance of volunteerism and financial contributions to these agencies. However, outside organizations are discouraged from soliciting funds in the schools. Any fundraising project conducted by students and faculty must be recommended by the superintendent and approved by the board.

Students may be permitted to engage in raising funds for schools, school sponsored clubs, school sponsored athletic teams or humanitarian agencies if the fund-raising project is sponsored by the school and if:

1. the project has the approval of the board and is in compliance with the system's administrative procedures;
2. students are made aware of the voluntary nature of participation; and
3. no pressure is exerted on students to participate.

By September 15 of each school year, the principal shall submit to the superintendent a list of proposed fund raising activities proposed to be sponsored by the school, or school sponsored clubs or athletic teams through January 15 of the following year.

By January 15 of each school year, the principal shall submit to the superintendent a list of proposed fund raising activities proposed to be sponsored by the school, or school sponsored clubs or athletic teams through September 15 of that same year.
