Cross References:

Any teacher may enter into an agreement with parents for tutoring children for a fee; however, teachers are prohibited from tutoring for pay students assigned to them. The principal shall be informed of the agreement and the terms of the agreement.

Tutoring for a fee may not take place within or on school facilities or premises and not during regular work hours. School supplies shall not be expended in tutoring provided for a fee.

Neither the Board, principal or administrators shall be involved in setting tutoring fees. Fees should be mutually agreed upon by parent and teachers.

Each school office is encouraged to maintain a list of tutors in the geographic area of the system. Any teacher wanting to submit his/her name for the list may do so. The list will be made available to any person interested in securing tutoring services.
