PURPOSE OF SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

You will also receive notification that will inform you of provider's name, starting date, session length in minutes, number of weekly sessions, total number of sessions and location.

Dear Parent or Guardian,

I am writing to tell you about the Supplemental Educational Services (SES), or free tutoring, **for students who receive free or reduced-cost lunch.** SES will be offered outside the regular school day. The purpose of these services is to ensure that Oxford Elementary School students increase their academic achievement in reading and mathematics by getting extra help. If there is not enough funding for every **eligible** child requesting services, **students with the greatest academic need will receive first priority.**

If you would like to request tutoring services, complete the **yellow registration form for each child and return the form to the school.** **The last day to register is September 23, 2011.** The Provider Fair will give you more information to help you decide which provider best meets the needs of your child. After receiving your request for services, the district will assign a provider to your child and confirm your request by mail. Next, an agreement with the service provider, including specific achievement goals for your child, will be established and a start date will be set. SES services will begin the last week in October.
