



Lt Col Hall was born in Louisville, Kentucky in 1960. He earned his Bachelor of Science Degree in Economics from the University of Kentucky in 1983, and his Master of Business Administration from the University of Kentucky in 1985. In 1985, he was directly commissioned into the United States Air Force as a Medical Service Corps Officer. Lt Col Hall is also a Fellow in the American College of Healthcare Executives.

Upon completion of the Health Services Administration course in 1985, he reported to Eglin Air Force Base, Florida as a Medical Logistics Intern. He moved to Edwards Air Force Base, California in 1986, where he was the Director, Medical Logistics Management. In 1990, he reported to Shaw Air Force Base, South Carolina. During this assignment, he was the Director of

Medical Logistics Management and then transitioned to become the Director of Resource Management. In 1992, he was assigned to Brooks Air Force Base, Texas as Medical Logistics and Contracting fellow with Headquarters Air Force Medical Support Agency.
