NEW SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

***SECU – People helping People** – Any BHHS senior can apply for this scholarship. Students must attend one of the public NC colleges or universities, be a resident of NC, have a 2.5 GPA or higher and demonstrate leadership, excellence of character, integrity, an community involvement. **Applications are available in Mrs. Moore's office and is due to Mrs. Moore by March 30th.**

***Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Scholarship** - criteria for scholarship: senior, African-American female, 2.8 or higher GPA, accepted to an accredited college or university for the fall – see Mrs. Moore for an application. Application **deadline is February 29, 2012**

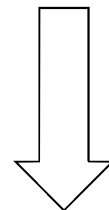

FAFSA information

EVERYONE THAT PLANS TO FURTHER THEIR EDUCATION AFTER HIGH SCHOOL NEEDS TO FILL OUT THIS FORM !

You will need to complete the FAFSA online.

You will need to get a PIN number first. (you need one and so do one of your parents/guardians) To get a pin number, go to www.pin.ed.gov

Once you have a pin number, go to this website www.fafsa.ed.gov and fill out the form.

This is a free application!

SENIORS if you plan to change your schedule for 2nd semester and have applied or been accepted to a college or university you will need to contact them and bring documentation that the change will not effect your acceptance.

REMINDER to all Seniors!!!

Check with your counselor after 1st semester to make sure you have all your credits/classes that you need to graduate.

Seniors make sure you take care of any debt you may owe before May (books, lunch money, uniforms, etc)
