Kenneth N Houston Memorial Scholarship- any senior interested in a construction related field may apply (construction mgmt, civil engineering, architecture, drafting, and related fields). Please see Mrs. Moore in the counseling office for an application. Deadline- April 27th

The National CO-OP Scholarship Program- to be eligible for the merit co-op scholarship the student must apply, be accepted, and attend one of the eight partner colleges and universities. See www.co-op.edu for more information. Deadline to apply is Feb. 15th, 2012.

Nursing Scholarship—NC ELKS Association- accepted to a college/university that has a nursing program, applicants should be in the top 25% of their class, unweighted GPA 2.5 and above, other requirements as stated. See Mrs. Moore for application. Deadline **December 2nd**.
