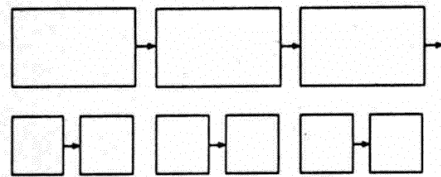

I will begin reading benchmark testing on September 12. Each child is tested in word recognition, word usage (making up sentences with given word) and reading comprehension. These will give me a reading level somewhere between A to U. These tests will take a few weeks!
