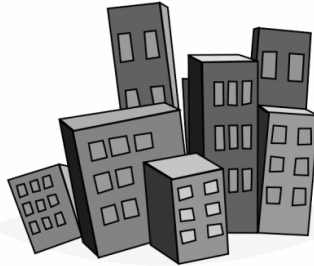


Itty Bitty City

You may do more than one! All community buildings or places are due on January 3. On that day, all city planners will meet together to layout and create Itty Bitty City.

Grading Rubric

Level 4 requirements (the best of the best):

- *At least 3 buildings are listed in each column on the chart
- *Buildings listed are placed in correct columns
- *building created is creative, neatly put together, and appropriate for your chosen community (ie, a barn/home for rural, skyscraper/office building for urban)

Level 3 requirements (Okay job!):

- *1-2 buildings listed in each column
- *most of the buildings are listed in correct columns
- *building may be neat, appropriate for your community, or creative, but not all three.

Level 2 requirements (so-so job):

- *0-1 building listed in each column
- *most of the buildings listed are not correct
- *building is a bit messy, not the right fit for the community, or lacks much thought for details.

Level 1:

- *some columns are blank
- *building is not complete
