

## Kindergarten Additional Activities

1. A Magic School Bus video will be used to introduce "Recycling, Reusing and Reducing."
2. Students will discuss with their teachers the ways they can act now to help planet Earth.
3. Earth Day will be celebrated as Kindergarten's "Green Day."
  - a. Teachers will lead students on another tour of the building. Locations to be explored include the tankless hot water heaters, bicycle rack and showers, electrical and communication room, mechanical rooms and soundproofing, going outside to view the water collection area and observing the white roof.
  - b. Students will watch a Discovery Education video, "Stuff Happens with Bill Nye." The video will highlight eco-friendly things to do at home, especially in the kitchen. Students will talk with our cafeteria staff about their Energy Star appliances.
  - c. Students will make posters for the school and refrigerators at home dealing with the ways to stay "Green."
  - d. Students will participate in a Trash Collection and create maps for locations of trash then graph the amounts of trash collected per area.
4. Students will read with their class, "The Dumpster Diver" or "Earth Day Hooray." Upon completion of the classroom reading students will create bubble maps to discuss the book.
5. Kindergartners will participate in a Rotation Day of "Green Activities."
